CLCC's conference starts on Tuesday evening, April 5th, with Rev. Rob Jarvis presenting "**The Road to Augsburg and Beyond.**" He will provide a quick look at the historical conditions before Augsburg that came to threaten the very existence of the Reformation. Attendees will see the conviction of those who sought to preserve the truth and be encouraged to stay strong in their own confessional identity. The \$15 registration fee includes CLCC's newest book, *The Reformation and Confessions*.

On Wednesday morning, April 6th, Rev. Jeremiah Johnson will be presenting "**Catechesis Begins in the Home**". Parents know they are responsible to pass on
